**Dr. Blase's Qualifications**

*Dr. Jo Blase is a research Professor Emerita of educational administration and leadership and a former school administrator. Since receiving her Ph.D. from the University of Colorado her research has focused on instructional and transformational leadership, school governance and reform, professional development, discourse analysis of principal-teacher communications, and workplace mistreatment of teachers. She also conducts research on supervisory discourse among physicians as medical educators and consults with physicians in US hospitals and medical centers. She has received the AASA Outstanding Research Award, the CU Research Award, the Walker Award for Excellence in Research, and several university teaching awards; she consults with educators considering legal matters; and she holds doctoral review appointments to universities in and outside of the US. Dr. Blase's nine book editions include several bestsellers as well as *Handbook of Instructional Leadership*, *Handbook of School Improvement: How High-Performing Principals Create High-Performing Schools* and *Breaking the Silence: Overcoming the Problem of Principals' Mistreatment of Teachers*. Professor Blase has published over 90 academic articles, chapters, and books as well as monographs, book reviews, bulletins/reports, media and on-line publications, and numerous international and national refereed papers. She serves on editorial and review boards and serves educators in training and consulting capacities.*
